2. Trip Leader acquisition, recognition and retention - a. Awareness, b. Communication/support, c. Continued leader growth

3. Inaccurate data displayed - a. Event Leader Status, b. Trip Leader School – front facing information for all Group programs

4. Lack of awareness about staff roles

Steps being taken (now and in the future):

1. Standardizing statewide procedures and resources – Collaborating with Julie Luce (general TLS) and Brian Le Blanc (TTL) to standardize Trip Leader School resources

2. Trip Leader Task Force – Collective team of Group representatives collaborating to share ideas, current processes and areas they need support

3. Updating leader training - CMC ambassadors – New Member Hikes

4. Leader Communication - a. Welcome email to new leaders - Welcome packet (letter, leader

resources and leader hat), b. Trip Leader Task force, c. Fireside Chats, d. The Lead

5. Leader benefits, swag, and Scholarship Program - What do the leaders want?

6. Leader Status Project - a. New leader support, b. Longtime leaders (Badges/patches)

How State Council can support:

1. Communication consistency - a. Awareness of staff's roles and support, b. Policy enforcement, c. Information distribution - Disseminate to Group leaders

2. Ideation - Suggestions and feedback always welcome

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3. Leadership Summit - a. Remind people to sign up for Saturday May 21! b. Join us
