#### CLASSES

#### Avalanche Terrain Avoidance:

This seminar consists of pre-course work by students on their own; a two hour presentation by Zoom and a 3-hour field exercise for those who wish to AVOID avalanche terrain. This is particularly important given the high avalanche danger this year. CMC members and non-members are welcome to sign up for a Zoom presentation <u>Tuesday (2/2)</u>. There is a fee. The currently scheduled field sessons are at Jones Pass (close to Berthoud Pass). When this course is offered in 2022, we hope to have a field day scheduled in the Western Slope.

<u>Wilderness First Aid</u> is now a hybrid 16-hour online plus a 1-day in-person field class. This serves as both an initial certification and recertification. \$200 members, \$245 nonmembers, and 5 spots each class are free for leaders with online application and 6 trip commitment in 2 years. Western Slope field day location TBD due to COVID distancing precautions. More info <u>here</u> and dates will be added regularly when distancing restrictions are lowered.

<u>Trip Leader Training</u>: We are seeking new trip leaders! The free training consists of online modules and one training hike plus wilderness first aid. 
