On August 13 2021, the Grand Mesa, Uncompanyee, and Gunnison National Forests (GMUG) released its Draft Forest Plan for public comment. If you adventure in the San Juans, West Elks or on Grand Mesa, now is your chance to help preserve high-quality recreation on these landscapes.



Right now, the plan falls short on strong recreation policy and new wilderness recommendations your feedback will help direct the forest to make important changes benefiting recreation and conservation for the next 20-30 years.
